Road Closure on A303 2022-5

The Reopening of the A303 will be delayed until Winter 2025

- Road access to the Davis Hall from all directions. For the foreseeable future, do not rely on the A303 between Podimore Roundabout and Sparkford Roundabout being open. Access from A303 down Howell Hill is officially closed until Winter 2025
- The Davis Hall can be approached on the A303 from the east as follows: travel along A303 to the Sparkford Roundabout, go down through Queen Camel to small roundabout, take second exit, drive a mile and a bit, turn right into West Camel, over bridge, follow road up Howell Hill to Davis Hall. The village speed limit is 20MPH.
- Access from the west on A303: at Podimore Roundabout take exit Podimore and Services, follow the road (take care at sharp right bend), cross junction with B3151, travel 1.5 miles, turn left into West Camel. This route is not advisable in very wet weather due to likelihood of flooding at junction with B3151.
 - Alternative access from the west on A303 as of end January 2024:

approaching from Podimore Roundabout on the A303: Take the slip road to Ilchester Yeovilton (no mention of West Camel!). This is called the Steart Hill Overbridge. Follow it over the A303 to traffic lights at T-junction immediately over the bridge. Turn right, then turn left down into West Camel.

- From Plowage Lane, West Camel on return journey heading west on A303, turn left on to the old A303 for a short distance, then it will to run temporarily on the eastbound carriageway of the new A303.
